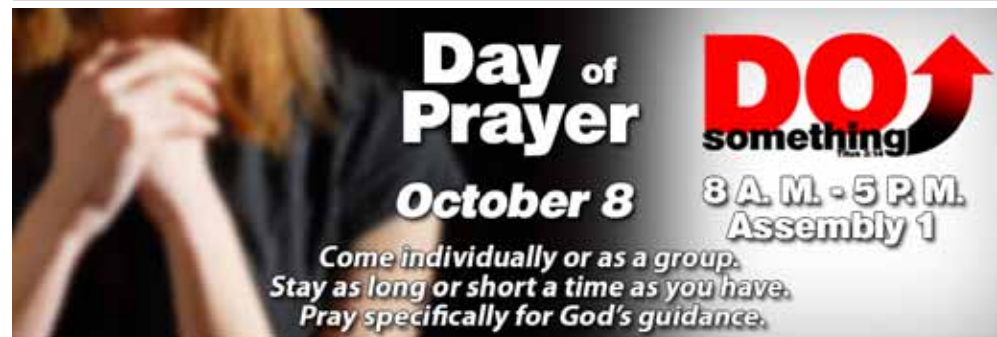
FBCS Pecan Sale

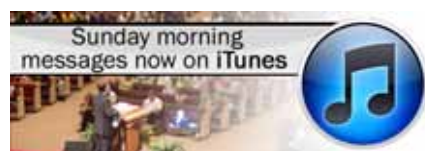
