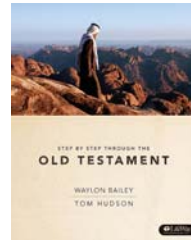
## DONOR Records

## Step By Step Through the Old Testament

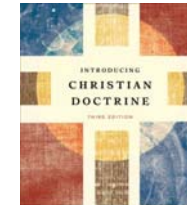

## The Battle Plan for Prayer

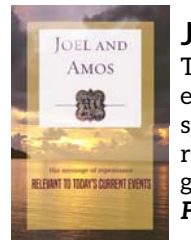
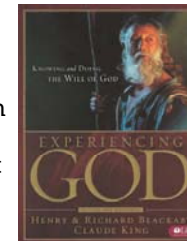

## Joel and Amos

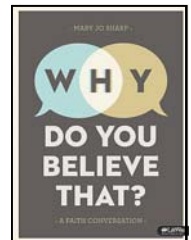
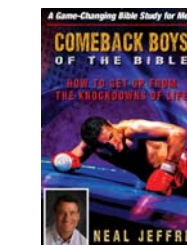
